

## **KNOW BEFORE YOU GO – GENERAL TICKETS**

### **HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS:**

Ticket holders will need to bring a photo ID and either their physical vaccination card or a photo of their vaccination card. Unvaccinated patrons and children under 12 must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test: either a PCR test taken within 72 hours of box office check in or an antigen test taken within 24 hours.

Masks will also be required at all indoor festival venues, except when consuming a beverage, and must fully cover the nose and mouth.

All venues are operating at reduced capacity to encourage social distancing.

Hand Sanitizing stations are located throughout all the venues.

### **PARKING:**

Since there will be no street closures, parking may be found on all streets and surface lots throughout the Grand Center Arts District.

### **TICKETS:**

Day of ticket sales are only available at the Fox Theatre Box Office (527 North Grand Blvd.)

Friday, September 10 – 5:30 p.m.-10 p.m.

Saturday, September 11 – Noon-10 p.m.

Sunday, September 12 – 11 a.m.-10 p.m.

General Admission tickets may be redeemed at any of the theater box offices for a wristband.

Guests attending multiple days will need to check in at one of the box offices each day.

### **BAG POLICY:**

Approved Bags:

Wallets, small clutch bags, are acceptable. No large backpacks.

Diaper bags (with child) after inspection

### **DOORS:**

Doors open one hour prior to the first band taking the stage.
